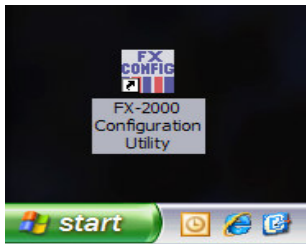
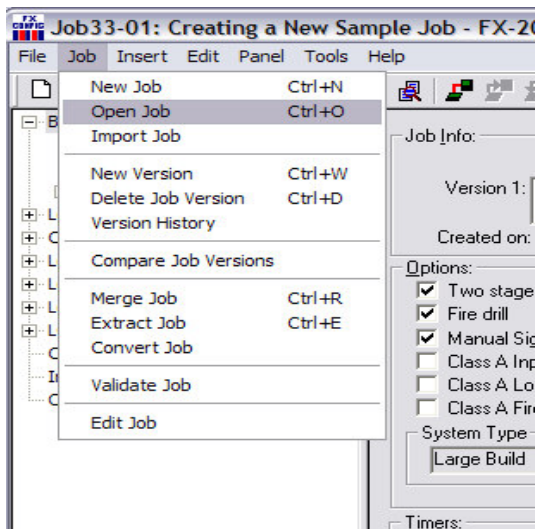


How to copy an FX-2000 database Job

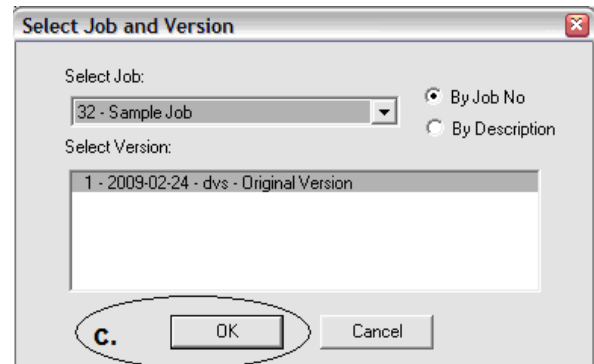
1. Open the latest FX-2000 Configurator.



2. a. Open the database job you would like to copy
b. Select the version of the job.
c. Click **OK**

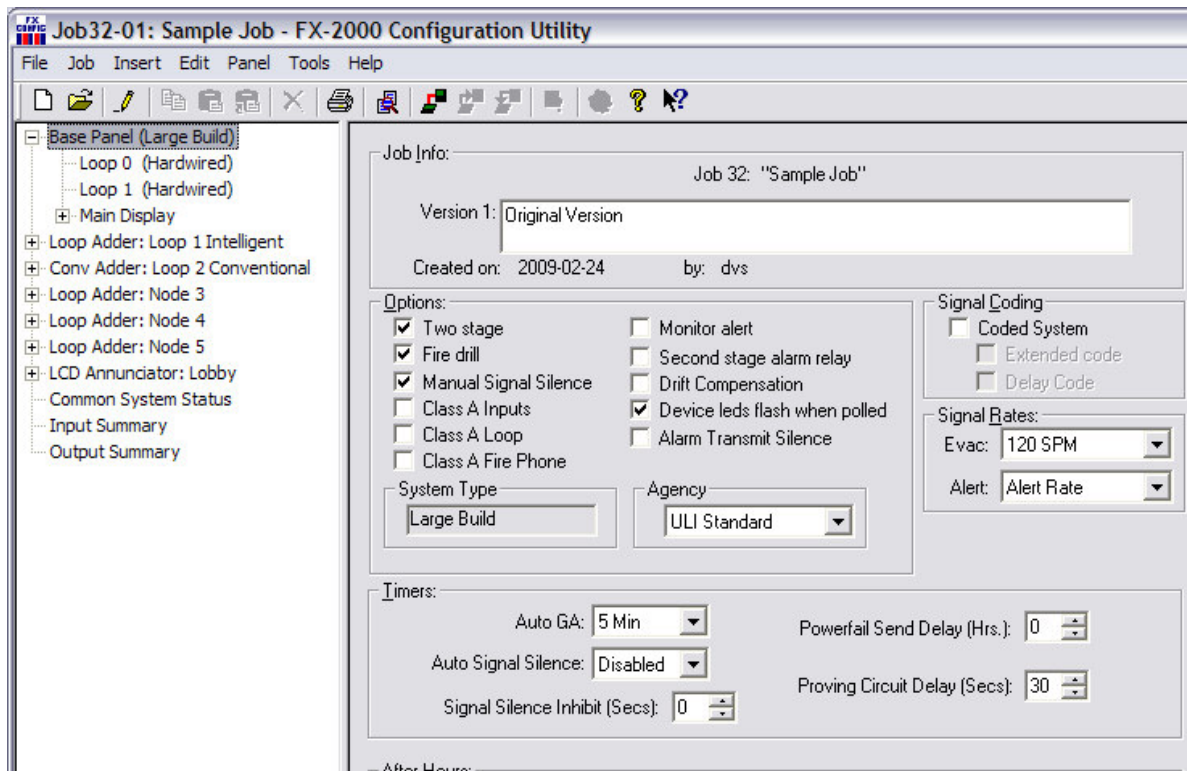

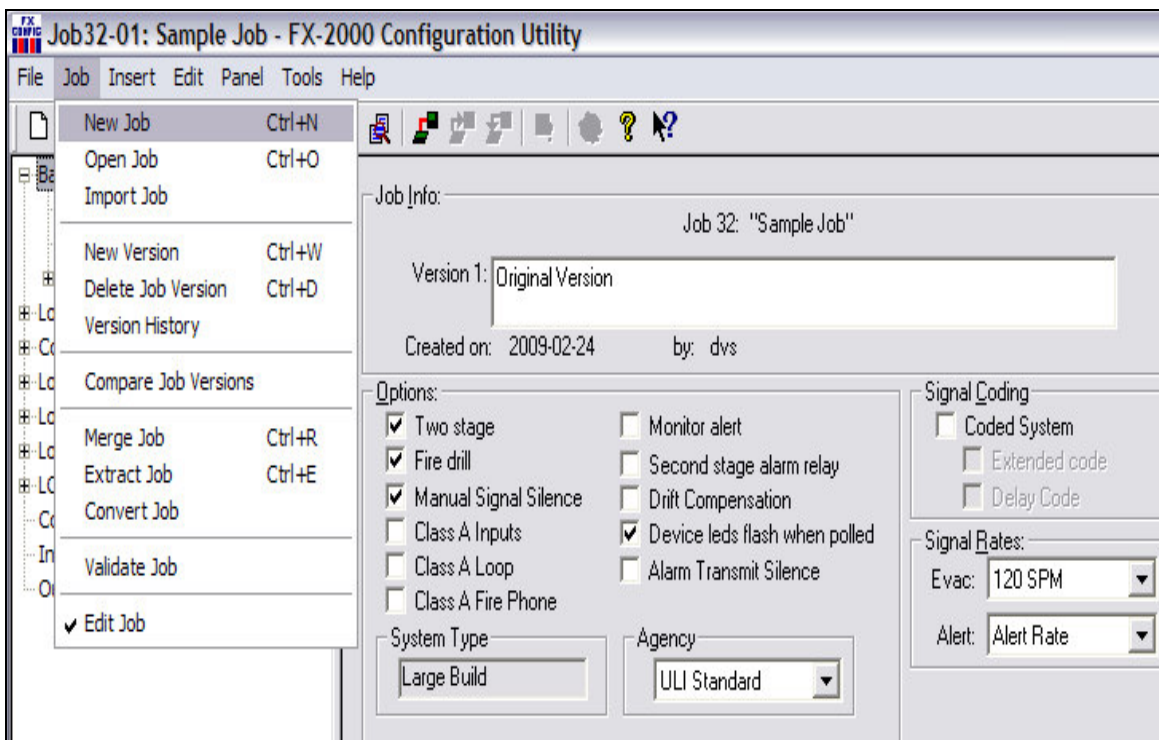

3. The database job to be copied should now be displayed on the FX Configurator



4. Click on **Job** tab and then scroll down to **New Job**.

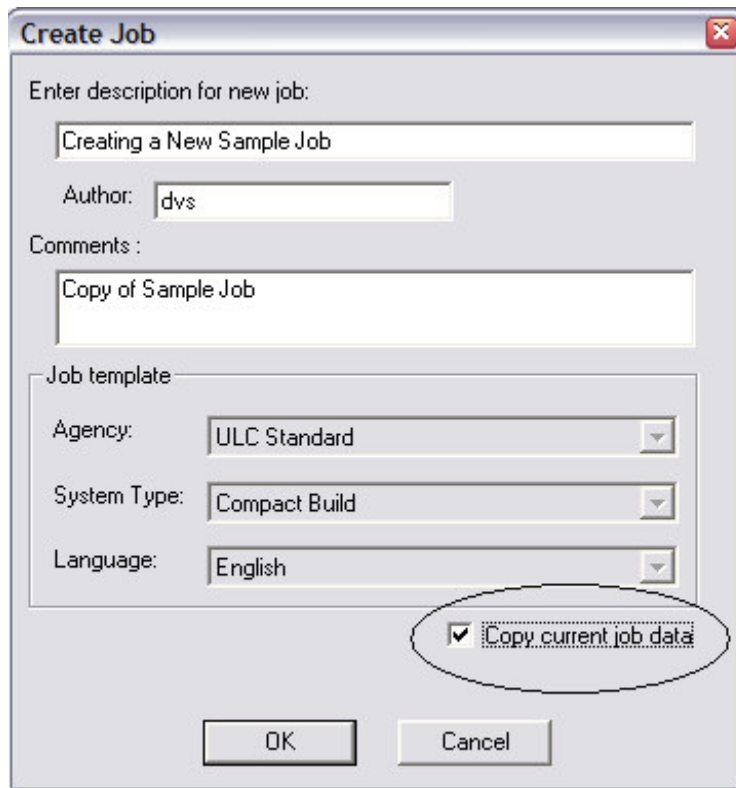

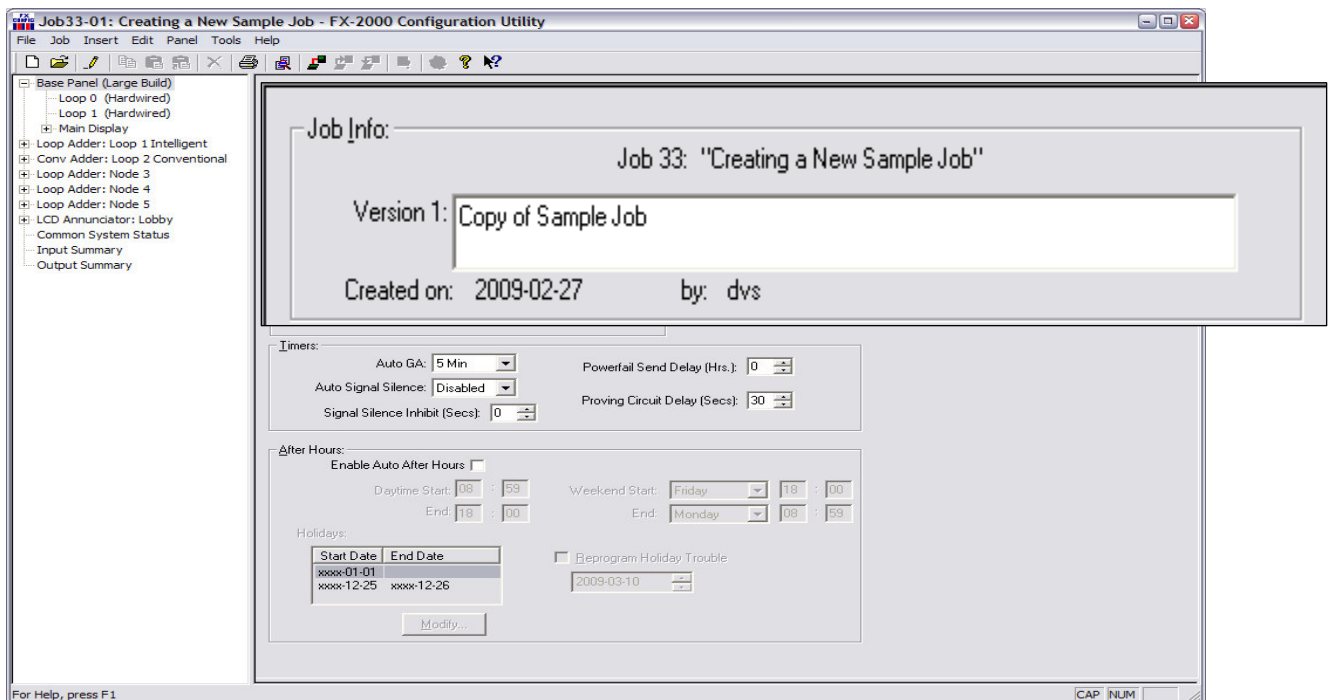

7. Now make sure you place a check mark in the box labeled **Copy current job data**

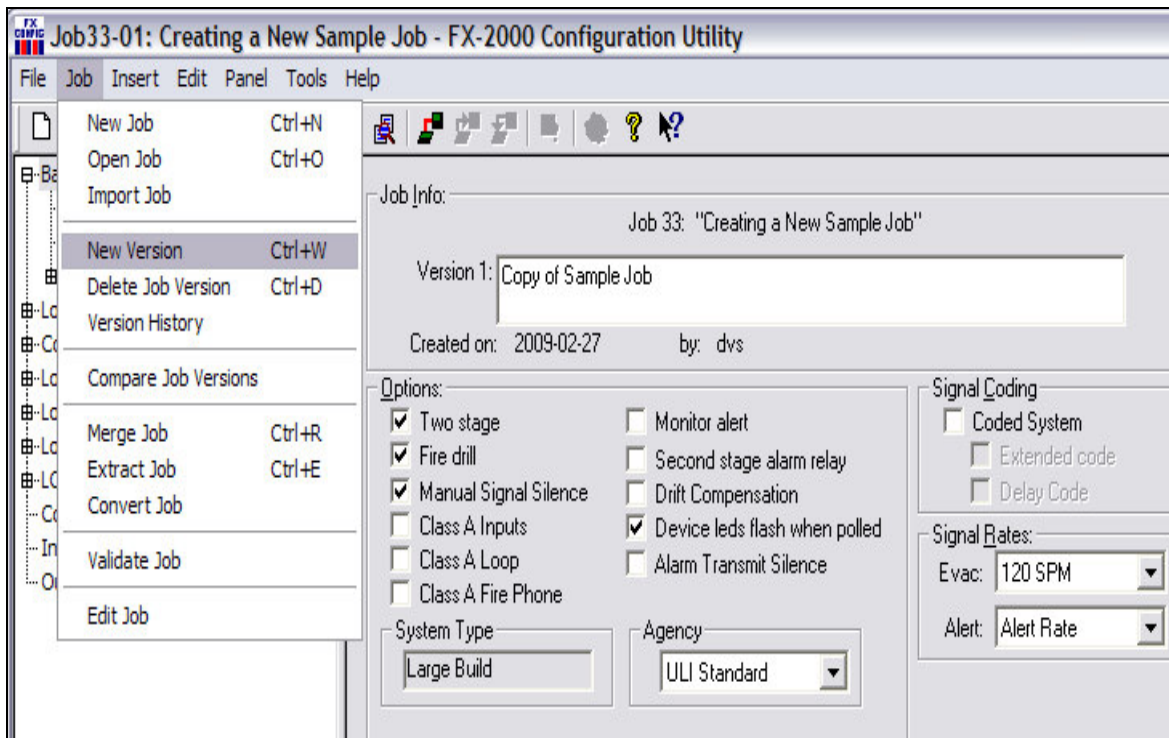


8. The FX Configurator will now copy the current opened job and display its new name and comment

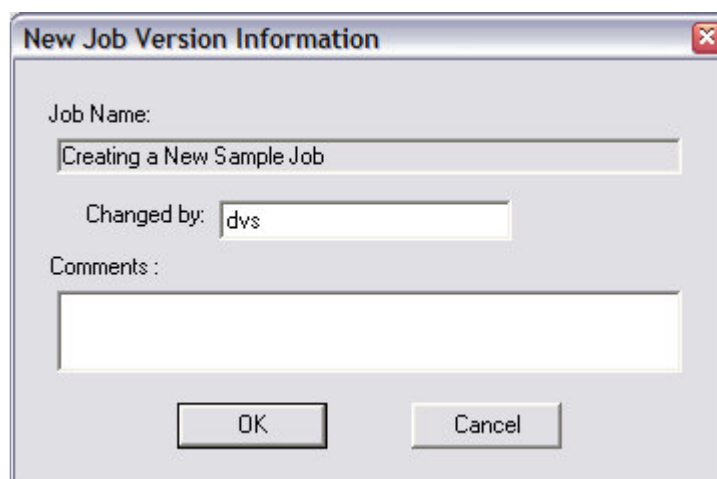


How to create a new version of a database job


1. To create a New Version of a database job simply click on **Job** tab and then scroll down to **New Version**.



2. A new window opens up labeled **New Job Version Information**.




3. You will notice the Job Name will stay the same but will only allow you to change the **Comments** for the new database version



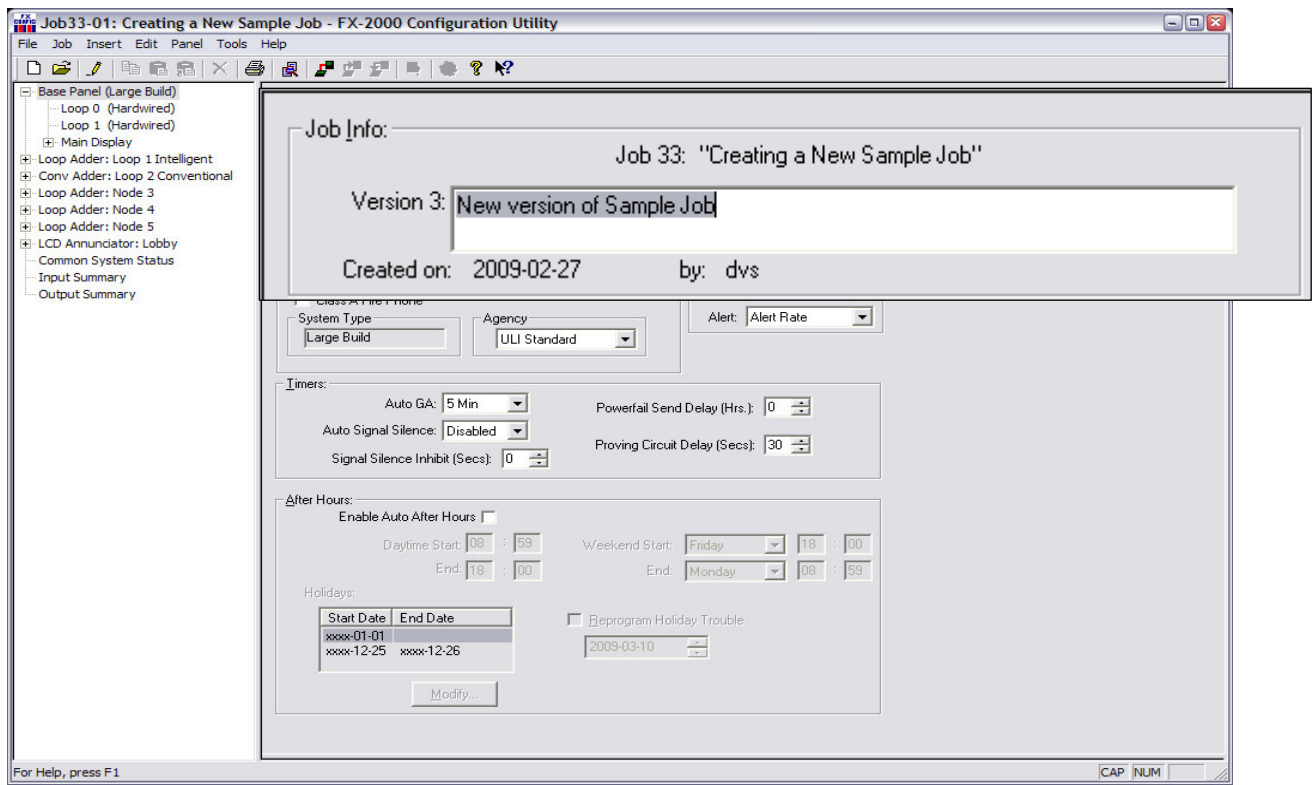
